I. BEFORE THE AGENDA:

Gergely Mészner opened the meeting and recorded the excusals of Nóra Virág Vada and Marco Leoni. Márk Péter Bálint, Benedek Sütő, Krisztián Filep, Édua Lili Denk, Bendegúz Ákos Mátravölgyi and Márk János Molnár requested to participate online. Arsyla Najwa Safa attended representing the Supervisory Board, and Dóra Haraszti attended as Head of the Events Department.

Arsyla Najwa Safa was appointed as keeper of the minutes and teller of votes. The Chair established that the Delegates' Assembly was quorate and informed members that the meeting would be recorded for the purpose of preparing the minutes.

II. ADOPTION OF THE AGENDA:

The agenda previously sent out:

Gergely Mészner proposed modifications to the previously circulated agenda. Due to the late arrival of the final budget framework for 2026, the Presidency was unable to prepare the full budget proposal in time. Therefore, he proposed removing the approval of the 2026 budget from the agenda and discussing it as an informational point after the agenda. He further proposed changing the order of the agenda items.

The Delegates' Assembly adopted the agenda with 12 votes in favour, 0 against, and 2 abstentions. (Quorum: 14/20)

III. DISCUSSION OF THE AGENDA ITEMS:

1. Election of a new Vice President responsible for Student Life

Submitter: Gergely Mészner

Gergely Mészner informed the Assembly that one valid application had been received for the position, submitted by Dóra Haraszti.

Dóra Haraszti presented her programme, summarizing her four years of experience within the Students' Union and her work as Head of the Events Department. She reflected on the successful renewal of the freshman integration programme, the improvement in event quality and attendance, and the strengthening of dormitory and collaborative events. She outlined her vision for the Vice President position, emphasizing coordinated leadership of the Events, Communications and International Departments, structural stability, effective internal communication, and systematic knowledge transfer. She stressed the importance of supporting international integration and maintaining high professional standards across all areas.

No questions were raised by the Delegates' Assembly. Following the vote, Arsyla Najwa Safa announced the results: 14 votes in favour, 0 against and 0 abstentions.

Resolution No. KGY-2/2025/2026. (29 January 2026)

The Delegates' Assembly unanimously elected Dóra Haraszti as Vice President responsible for Student Life.

2. Reflection on the First Semester by the Presidency

Submitter: Gergely Mészner

Gergely Mészner informed the Assembly that the written report of the Presidency would be circulated later and would be subject to written voting. He provided a brief oral reflection, highlighting in particular the issue concerning the continuation of small language courses. He explained that following the university's announcement to discontinue several language programmes, the Students' Union initiated a survey with over 1,500 responses and entered into negotiations with university leadership. As a result, a compromise was reached: the courses will continue in the spring semester, and a revised system will be introduced from the next autumn semester, including tuition fees for lower levels and regulatory amendments requiring future approval.

Réka Nikolényi briefly reflected on her semester as outgoing Vice President, noting progress in the International and Communications Departments, including growth in the advisory board and improvements in the Pannonia scholarship process.

Barnabás Bányai summarized his work in the areas of social support, scholarships, dormitory matters and administrative improvements.

László Hegedűs reported on organisational evaluation, financial management, the material grant programme, recruitment and onboarding developments, and emphasized the importance of structured documentation and long-term sustainability.

No further questions were raised. The report will be subject to written voting later.

3. Approval of the budget report of 2025

Submitter: Gergely Mészner

Gergely Mészner presented the 2025 budget report and acknowledged responsibility for the year-end surplus of approximately 3 400 000 HUF. He emphasized that underspending, particularly in student-support areas such as the material grant, must be avoided in the future and that structural improvements would be introduced to prevent similar outcomes.

Following the vote, the Delegates' Assembly approved the 2025 budget report with 12 votes in favour, 2 against and 1 abstention.

Resolution No. KGY-3/2025/2026. (29 January 2026)

The Delegates' Assembly supported with 11 votes in favour, 2 against and 1 abstention the approval of the budget report for 2025.
